Taxes are payable on or after the 15th day of February succeeding the levy.

Failure to pay the FIRST half by April 30th makes the FULL 1964 tax delinquent and interest at 8% per annum shall be charged upon such unpaid taxes. First half payment cannot be made after April 30, 1964.

The second half tax becomes delinquent after October 31st following date due, and interest at 8 per cent per annum is charged from October 31st until paid.

If you do not receive a statement in February of taxes on your property, be sure to contact the Treasurer's office, either by mail or telephone, requesting such statement and giving legal description of your property. A statement will be mailed at once.

#### TAX FORECLOSURES OF REAL ESTATE

Property may be foreclosed for taxes five years after date of delinquency. After foreclosure a deed is issued to the purchaser from which there is no redemption.

Be sure that the description on your statements cover the property on which you desire to pay tax, and that your address is correct.
