

821 calls, 41% Fire/59% EMS.

July-Aug-Sept = 35% Call Volume

Shoulder Seasons May-Jun and Oct-Nov = 33% Call Volume

Remaining 5-Months; Jan-Feb-Mar-Apr-Dec = 22%
